

**Dr. Klaus Grabinski**

Dr. Klaus Grabinski is a Judge of the German Federal Court of Justice (Bundesgerichtshof) since 2009. He is member of the 10<sup>th</sup> Civil Division (X. Zivilsenat) which has, *inter alia*, jurisdiction on patent dispute matters. Before, he was Presiding Judge at the District Court in Duesseldorf where he chaired a Civil Division that dealt mainly with patent disputes (2001 – 2009), Judge at the Court of Appeal in Duesseldorf (2000 – 2001), Legal Researcher at the Federal Court of Justice (Bundesgerichtshof) (1997 – 2000) and Judge at the District Court in Duesseldorf (1992 – 1997).

Dr. Grabinski studied law at the Universities of Trier, Geneva and Cologne and was university assistant at the University of Trier.

He is co-author of a commentary on the European Patent Convention (Benkard, Europäisches Patentübereinkommen) and a commentary on the German Patent Law (Benkard, Patentgesetz, 10th ed.). He is author of a multitude of articles concerning Patent Law, Civil Procedure and International Private Law. He is a frequent speaker at national and international conferences on IP Law.
