Clark Lackert is a partner in Dickstein Shapiro's Intellectual Property Practice. Mr. Lackert primarily focuses his practice on trademark, copyright, domain name, licensing, and anti-counterfeiting matters, with a particular expertise in the international arena. He has worked on numerous acquisitions and divestitures involving due diligence for intellectual property assets and regularly counsels on intellectual property management. Mr. Lackert also is an arbitrator for the World Intellectual Property Organization in Geneva, Switzerland in connection with Internet domain name disputes and has been a consultant with the U.S. Government on implementation of the World Trade Organization TRIPS Agreement concerning trademark, patent, and copyright issues.

Mr. Lackert has supervised multinational legal teams in various jurisdictions, obtaining injunctions against defendants and transfers pirated domain names. Recently, he won an important appellate court decision in the United Arab Emirates concerning trade name and trademark use and registration of a client's corporate name; won a trademark litigation case in the Supreme Court of South Korea; and has handled many court actions and raids in China. Mr. Lackert also counseled on global requirements for an international trademark licensing initiative of a multinational client and worked with a name generation firm to analyze trademark availability and suitability for a global rebranding project for a major U.S. corporation.

Mr. Lackert is admitted to practice in New York and is admitted to the Eastern and Southern districts of New York and to the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit. He has chaired a number of International Trademark Association (INTA) committees, including the current INTA Contributory Liability Task Force, which was recently organized to develop the organization's position on contributory trademark infringement with regard to online marketplace sites. He has also served as Chair of the ABA Trademark and Copyright Divisions, and is a former member of the Executive Committee of the INTA Board of Directors. Mr. Lackert also is Secretary of the Board of Directors of World Cares Center, Chair of IPO Draft Applicant Guidebook (DAGv4) for New gTLDs Thick WHOIS Issue Task Force, and outgoing President of the United States Group of the International Association for the Protection of Intellectual Property (AIPPI). Prior to joining Dickstein Shapiro, Mr. Lackert served as Deputy Practice Group Leader of the Intellectual Property Group of King & Spalding.

Mr. Lackert received his A.B., *cum laude*, from Cornell University and his J.D. from the State University of New York at Buffalo. He also holds an LL.M. in Trade Regulation from New York University.
