

Mr Justice Henry Carr

Sir Henry Carr studied jurisprudence at Hertford College Oxford and obtained an LLM from the University of British Columbia for a thesis on legal protection of computer programs.

He was called to the bar in 1982 and took silk in 1998. He specialised in all aspects of intellectual property law, and appeared in many cases in the Patents Court, the Court of Appeal, the Supreme Court and the European Court of Justice. He was Chair of the Intellectual Property Bar Association from 2012 until his appointment to the High Court Bench, Chancery Division, in October 2015, as one of the judges of the Patents Court.
