Adam Mossoff is Professor of Law at George Mason University School of Law, and is a Senior Scholar at the Center for the Protection of Intellectual Property at George Mason, which he co-founded in 2012. He teaches patent law, trade secrets, trademark law, internet law and property law, and he has published extensively on how patents and other IP rights are fundamental property rights that should be secured to their owners and commercialized in the free market. He has testified before the United States Senate and the House of Representatives on patent legislation, and has been invited to speak on his research at the PTO, the FTC, the DOJ, the National Academy of Sciences, and the Smithsonian Institution. He is a frequent speaker at congressional staff briefings, professional conferences, and academic conferences on important issues in the patent policy debates, both nationally and internationally. He has published on hot-topic issues concerning patented innovation in the *New York Times*, *Slate*, *Investor's Business Daily*, and in other media outlets. He is an appointed member of the Amicus Committee of the American Intellectual Property Law Association, a member of the Public Policy Committee of the Licensing Executives Society, a member of the Academic Advisory Board of the Copyright Alliance. He is also a former Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the Intellectual Property Committee of the IEEE-USA, and continues as a member in good standing.

Professor Mossoff received his J.D. with Honors from the University of Chicago Law School, and he holds an M.A. in philosophy from Columbia University and a B.A. with High Distinction and High Honors in philosophy from the University of Michigan. Following law school, he clerked for the Honorable Jacques L. Wiener, Jr. of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit, and he was a John M. Olin Fellow in Law and Visiting Lecturer at Northwestern University School of Law.
